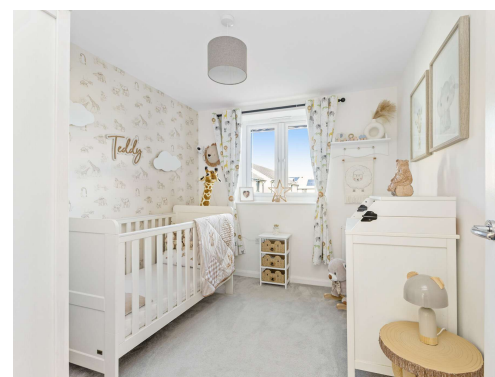
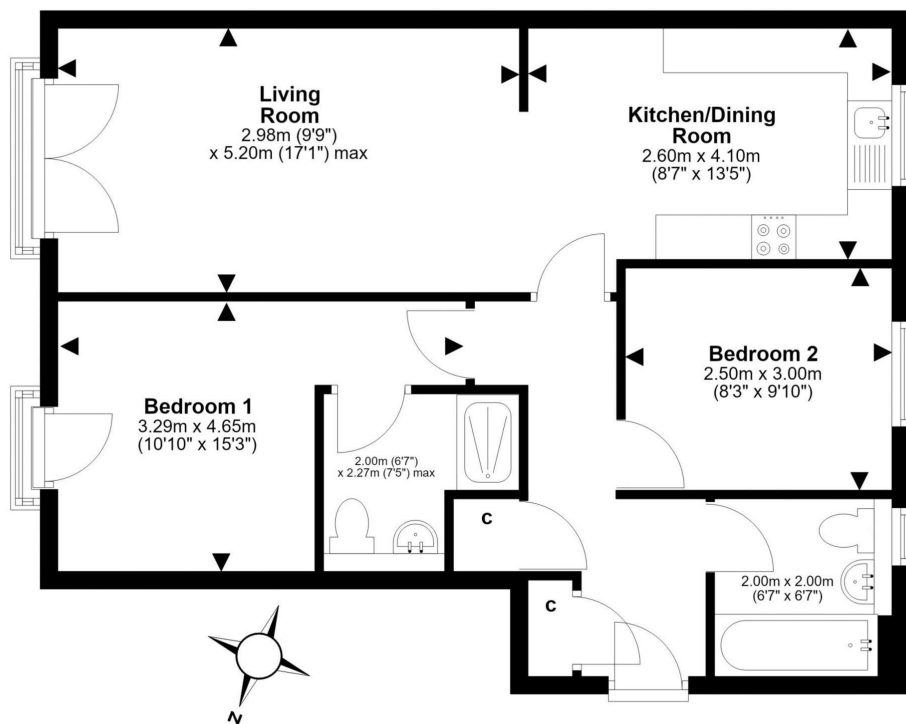
Location

Set some five miles southeast of the city centre, Craigmillar promises a fantastic setting for young families and professionals keen to escape the hustle and bustle of the capital, without leaving the city limits. The area is a short distance to the Royal Infirmary and Edinburgh University and schooling in the area is well-represented right through from nursery to senior level.
